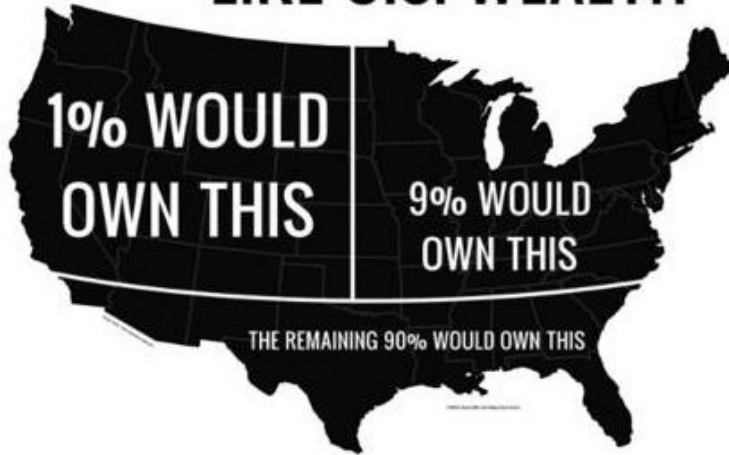

IF U.S. LAND WERE DIVIDED LIKE U.S. WEALTH



- 47 million people in the USA need government help in order to feed themselves.
- 15 million families owe more on their mortgage than the value of their home.
- More than 8 Million people lost their homes in the foreclosure crisis so far.
- The housing market has lost an est. \$4.9 trillion, with 59 million homes being stripped of value.

MORE NUMBERS & MORE REASONS TO SUPPORT OCCUPY CLEVELAND

- 66% of American make less than \$40k/ per year.
- .05% of Americans make more than \$1 million per yr.
- The top 1% of Americans control 43% of total financial wealth, with the next 19% controlling 50%. This leaves the bottom 80% controlling only 7% of total financial wealth.
- 25 million people in the USA can't find a full-time job.
- 50 million people in the USA live without health insurance.
